# Who we are

We are LIVE HAPPY NGO, from a small village-Assagao, Goa-India.

We strive towards bringing about eclectic solutions to societal problems through a Sustainable Development model.

Therefore our motto is to promote and achieve social empowerment by implementing a child-centered community approach.

Aligned with this mission we have a number of projects that run simultaneously to achieve this goal.

These are manifested into three main projects:

#### l. Live Clean

- Hosting regular clean-up drives and waste awareness programs in public/ tourist spots for a clean environment, in an effort to promote responsible tourism.

- Aid in waste management techniques and provide materials for awareness, within the community, in collaboration with different government organizations and public welfare bodies.

- Permaculture project, providing a medical herb garden and awareness for the rich biodiversity of Assagao

#### 2. Live Empower

- Learning classes, addresses the need for quality education among children of the community.

This venture is an attempt to fulfill the UN development goals for third world countries, for nurturing of the child's holistic growth.

- Awareness programs that seek to educate the masses about relevant topics in a society like basic human rights, hygiene issues, and empowering the girl child, to name a few. This is done by approaching local organizations like schools and colleges in aiding them to achieve this goal.

- Organizing and executing heritage walks through the promotion of heritage tourism. This is an attempt to preserve and protect the essence of Goan-ness, teaching people about culture and tradition to be implicated in business models.

#### 3. Two Lives project

- Providing cultural exchange programs for students from around the world to volunteer with our NGO for long term projects.

- Approaching different institutions abroad and at home to be trained and involve themselves in Social Welfare/Work.

### January

#### Let the Reading Commence!

The Bookworm Library had its first session in 2023, where they began with New Year's greetings and had various activities such as action songs, journal writing, book talks, and an art session. The art facilitator introduced the idea of using art to communicate specific messages and gave the children books to browse and discuss. The children were asked to sketch a plan of their painting and continued it in the next session. In the second session, they completed their paintings and shared their experiences and thoughts on their artwork.

The third and fourth sessions had interesting topics with read-aloud sessions, enhancing the children's critical thinking, and an art activity to enhance their understanding.







#### **Our After-School Learning**

This month children had their tests and with the help of the tutor, volunteer and coordinator children managed to study and answer their tests well. Each child received individual attention and assistance, and they were motivated to learn and understand their lessons.

#### Activity hour with the Volunteer

During academic learning for older children, volunteer Lara provided educational activities for younger children. These included creative revision of alphabets and math tables, games to improve motor skills, and art activities to enhance creativity.







## February

#### Interactive hour with our Spanish volunteers

Live Happy has welcomed two Spanish volunteers, Raquel and Uxue, who will be working on a documentary and volunteering with children for the next few months. The children were excited to meet them and learn more about their education and country.

Their first activity was creating their own Live Happy superhero, and the volunteers plan to work on cultural exchange and educational topics that will empower the children. They also taught the younger children about parts of the body using various learning materials.





February's Bookworm Library Sessions: A World of Reading for Kids

The Bookworm library sessions held in February were super exciting, as children were provided with a plethora of options to indulge in the world of reading. From book talks to journaling, the activities catered to different preferences. The library games and book browsing were also a hit among the kids.





#### **Live Happy Tuition classes**

At Live Happy, we offer an academic learning hour to provide personalized attention to students. This helps clarify doubts and improve the learning experience beyond regular classes. Students receive additional support and guidance from tutor during this time.





#### **Activity hour with the volunteers**

Our Volunteer conducts a "what am I feeling" circle with children at the beginning of each week. This helps children learn about their emotions and develop skills to manage them. It's also helpful for us to better understand the children we work with. Using emotion words can improve their vocabulary and aid in emotional identification.







# March

#### Let's Play!

Our children try their best to study well and give their best. But they also need short time out to ease up the knot in their head and refresh themselves. Through physical activities like sports, children's brain gets stimulated, so that there is more capacity, motivation and they are able to concentrate better.

We had Paulina, another German volunteer from the football club Forca Goa to do sports activities. She not only conducted football but a bunch of games and team building actions.

The children were the happiest. The volunteers, coordinator and tutor accompanied the children.

#### **Bookworm Library sessions**

In the first session of the month, the children danced, played interactive games, journaled about their week, heard an interesting story, and did an art activity inspired by Mandana art form of Rajasthan.

In the second session, the children had a stitching activity and book browsing time where they learned about stitching and answered questions about it.

Lastly, the children were introduced to the concept of Surrealism art, which they enjoyed because it allowed them to draw from their own imaginations.





#### **Finals are here!**

The month of final exams had arrived for the academic year 2022-23. To prepare, tutors gave weekly tests and volunteers helped students with assignments, reading lessons, and day-to-day English vocabulary and math. It was a helpful and enjoyable learning experience for everyone involved!







#### Activity hour with the volunteers

This month volunteers focused on topics of interest to children, such as sports, occupations, and math equations. They used videos to help children understand the topics and created worksheets and games to keep them engaged. Volunteers also adapted their teaching methods based on each child's level of understanding and addressed challenges in managing younger students.

Raquel and Uxue led outdoor activities and taught action songs to break up the learning routine. Overall, children have responded positively to the volunteers and enjoy interacting with them.











#### Enhancing creativity in the library

In the first session of the month, children played games, shared about their exam week, and had a book talk. They also listened to a read aloud story and made envelope covers. In the second session, they tried Warli painting and created their own story. In the last session, they explored wordless books and created their own illustration painting.





#### Beach clean -up

With a lot of commitment, we dedicated the first Sunday of April to Mother Nature and successfully accomplish the second Beach Clean-up of the Year at the Chapora Beach. We came together and met new faces but also long known faces there.

The Live Happy Team collaborated with Project Tres for the purpose of building a bigger community and creating a platform for sustainable exchange. Through that we could start in the day with new friendships, cleaning the beach, refreshments and we were lucky to experience a performance of acoustic music and mime.

In the end we collected around 40 Bags of Plastic, Glass and slippers.


#### **Kitchen Garden**

#### Bookworm

This month kids at Live Happy had a fun and creative time exploring poetry and composing their own song! The bookworm team also provided an engaging second session focused on books, with games and exploration of publishers, themes and illustrations.

The children enjoyed a session where they read a story about Ferdinand the Bull and then watched a movie about it. They also had an art-based session where they learned about textures by touching and feeling illustrations.











#### **Kitchen Garden workshop**

The permaculture project continued with a workshop for children, teaching them about the new kitchen garden. The workshop conducted by our volunteer covered topics such as plant growth, the needs of plants, and the advantages of self-sufficiency. The children were engaged and enthusiastic throughout the interactive session, which we finished up with a tricky quiz.

The workshop concluded with a creative activity where the children colored the kitchen garden with all the colors of the rainbow. The event aimed to inspire sustainability, a healthy lifestyle and continuous hands-on activities in the nature among the children.
